LEARN HOW TO PREPARE YOUR HOME FOR A POWER OUTAGE AND WHAT TO DO WHEN ONE OCCURS

A power outage occurs when the electrical power goes out. Planned or unexpected, it can last for days or longer, disrupting communications, water, transportation, stores, banks and other services. This may impact needs such as lighting, heating, cooling, communication, food and medicine refrigeration, cooking and medical equipment.

Plan now to have what you need and to know how to stay safe.

Some quick tips: Make a plan for refrigerating medicines and powering medical devices; if safe, go to an alternate location for heat or cooling; keep mobile phones and electronic equipment charged; keep freezers and refrigerators closed; unplug appliances and electronics to avoid damage from electrical surges; and use generators outdoors and at least 20' away from building openings.
