The successful bidder must sign a Release of Liability form, must accept the entire lot, and is responsible for picking up the poles from the District's Diamond Lake Substation yard located at 2620 Southshore Diamond Lake Road, Newport, WA 99156. All poles must be picked up no later than Thursday, September 26, 2024. If the winning bidder fails to pick up the poles by 3:00 p.m. on September 26, 2024, the District reserves the right to award the poles to the next highest bidder.

Washington, PO Box 190, Newport, WA. 99156, or at the Box Canyon Dam Visitors Center, 7492 Hwy. 31, PO Box 547, Ione, WA. 99139 until 5:00 p.m., Thursday, September 12, 2024. Indicate "Sealed Bid" on the outside of the envelope. The bids will be opened Monday, September 16, 2024 and awarded at the September 17, 2024 Board meeting.
